Can I service or adjust the springs myself? No. Garage door springs are under extreme tension and should only be handled by trained professionals. Attempting to adjust or replace them yourself is dangerous and could cause injury or further damage to the system. Which B&D; doors use torsion vs. extension springs? Most B&D; sectional doors, such as the Panelift® and Panelift® Icon, use torsion springs for smoother and quieter operation . B&D; roller doors typically use counterbalance systems engineered for high-cycle durability. Garage door springs won't last forever.
